BOOTCAMPS

Moving Up in Care: Skills Bootcamps

In Partnership with *Skills for Care*, these bootcamps help new and aspiring managers and specialist staff in the care sector gain the skills needed to advance, take on greater responsibilities and fill key vacancies.

Skills Bootcamp Pathways:

1. Level 4 CPD: Aspiring Managers Bootcamp

- For new or current managers looking to upskill
- Eligible for £55/unit reimbursement through the Learning Development Support Scheme (LDSS).

2. Level 3 Certificate: Supporting Individuals with Learning Difficulties

- Focused on effective support for individuals with learning needs.
- Full £315 reimbursed available through LDSS upon qualification completion.

3. Level 3 CPD: Management of Medication Course

- o Covers advanced medication practices and CQC standards.
- Not eligible for LDSS reimbursement.

BONUS: All bootcamps include *Oliver McGowan Tier 2* face-to-face training (worth £1,300).

Stepping Up in Early Years Bootcamp

Designed to support early years professionals in meeting Ofsted and EYFS standards, especially in SEN support.

Many nurseries lack trained SEN staff - this program addresses that gap.

- Trains designated staff to meet statutory SEN and equality standards.
- Delivered by a SEN expert with 30+years' experience.

PATHWAY TO GREATNESS

Zakk's Journey - From Learner to Leader

Zakk, a young man with learning difficulties, faced uncertainty and disengagement after leaving college. Like many in similar circumstances, he struggled to find direction and was economically inactive. Still, he remained open to new opportunities.

His breakthrough came through the **Open Doors Beyond Barriers** project, where he joined Winnovation's delivery of the **Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training in Learning Disabilities and Autism Awareness.** This programme is aimed at health and social care professionals, includes co-delivery by people with lived experience—bringing authenticity to the training.



Zakk joined as a participant with the potential to co-deliver. Over the three-day course, he showed exceptional engagement, developing key life and work skills such as independent travel, time management and research. 
